Roca Blanca July Graduates

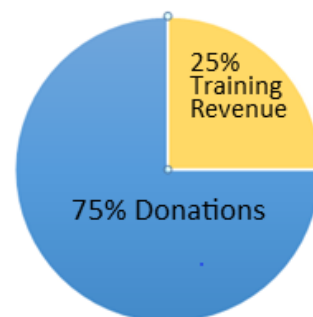
Although 2020 has proven to be a very challenging year, most of LTI's international training sites continue to press forward finding creative ways to train their students. Mexico had a total quarantine from March 28th - June 1st. So, Roca Blanca Mission Bible School completed their training online using Facebook Live and in July, held a graduation for 12 students.

The Founders of the Roca Blanca Bible School are pastors Duane and Sue Kershner. The school offers a three-year training program and integrates the LTI curriculum with its own courses throughout their three-year program. They have seven LTI Certified Instructors trained to teach the LTI curriculum and have graduated over 100 students. Missionary Charles Norton expressed that LTI's Leadership material is a very valuable part of their curriculum.
